# **A New Bern Christmas**

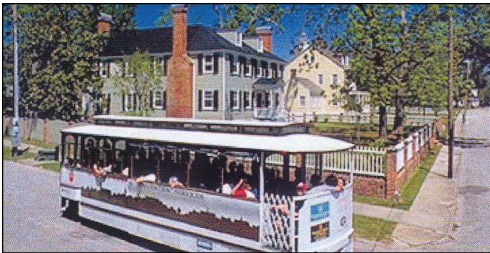
**“Christmas Traditions!” December 17-19, 2010**
