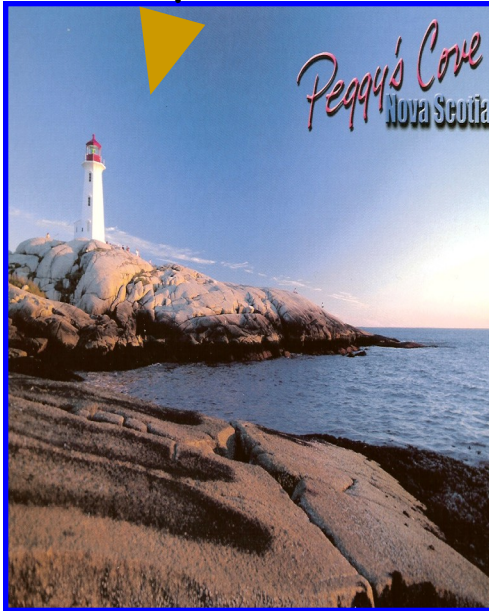

Day by Day Preliminary Itinerary

Day 1: Travel through SC, NC, VA, WV, and MD, as well as the Shenandoah Valley to Graniteville, PA.

Day 2: Today we continue on through PA, NJ, and NY as we make our way to Portsmouth, NH. (B)

Day 3: On our 3rd day, we'll travel to Bangor, ME where we will spend the night at the luxurious Hollywood Hotel & Slots. (D, B)

Day 4: Today we enter the Canadian Maritimes, meeting Don Smith, our Canadian guide, as we begin our tour of the Maritimes. After enjoying a tour we will spend the night at the famous Fairmount Algonquin Hotel. (B)

Day 5-6: After visiting the Reversing Falls in Saint John and Magnetic Hill in Monckton this morning, we leave New Brunswick via the Confederation Bridge and arrive in Prince Edward Island where we will spend the next 2 nights at The Inns on Great George...truly one of the most unique hotels you've ever had the good fortune to enjoy! While on Prince Edward Island, there will be time to visit "Anne of Green Gables," and be treated to a lobster dinner, of course! We'll also visit the Gouda Cheese lady and stop at the PEI Preserve Company. If the production, "Anne," is showing we will make this an optional evening activity. (1 B, 1 D)

Day 7-8: Today it's on to Cape Breton via the ferry where we will spend 2 nights at Gisele's on the shores of Bras d'Or Lake. Don Smith will take us on a breathtaking ride along the cliffs and seashore of Cape Breton Island. Last time we saw a moose! (2 B, 1L, 2 D)

Day 9-10-11: Our next destination is Halifax, Nova Scotia. We will spend the next 3 nights at the 4 Star Prince George Hotel and have 2 full days to visit Peggy's Cove, tour The Citadel, visit Mahone Bay and the city of churches, Lunenburg. We will also have free time to enjoy Halifax. (1 B)

Day 12: Today we leave Nova Scotia, traveling first through the country side with a morning stop at Grand Pre and a visit to Fort Anne, the most attacked site in Canadian history. This afternoon we catch the ferry from Digby to New Brunswick. Then it will be time to say our goodbyes to Don Smith, our guide for the last 9 days. Tonight we'll stay in St. John's, New Brunswick at the Hilton.

Day 13: Sadly, it's time to leave the Maritimes. However, today will be a special treat—we will spend tonight at the famous Bar Harbor Inn in oceanfront rooms! You will love it! Of course, we will first stop at the duty free shop and then re-enter the US...don't forget your passports! (B)

Day 14-16: Finally it is time to make our way South returning to our homes in South Carolina on the last day. On the way, we'll continue traveling through New England through the Shenandoah Valley—the Green Mountains, the Adirondacks, the Alleghenies, and the Poconos are just a few of the mountain ranges we'll enjoy viewing in route. 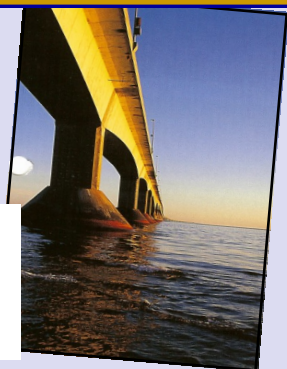
