



NEW ENGLAND FALL FOLIAGE

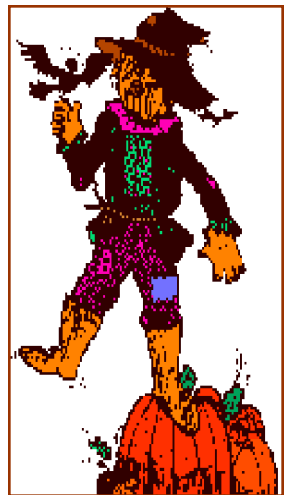

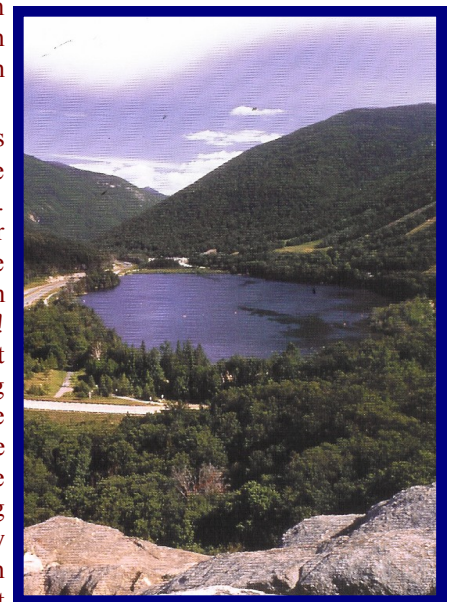
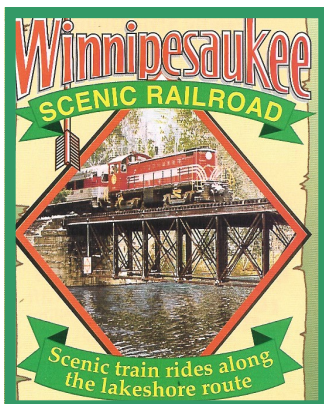
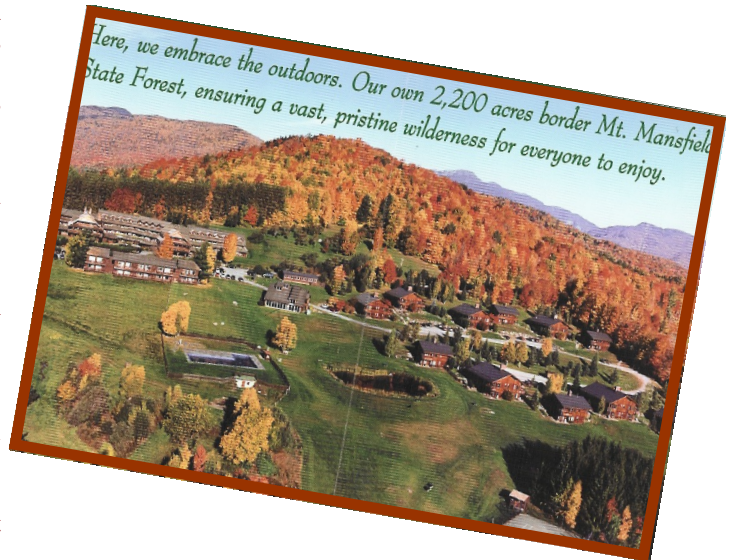
Day 3 Today it is on to ‘the rocky coast of Maine.’ We’ll enjoy some spectacular “water” views as we make

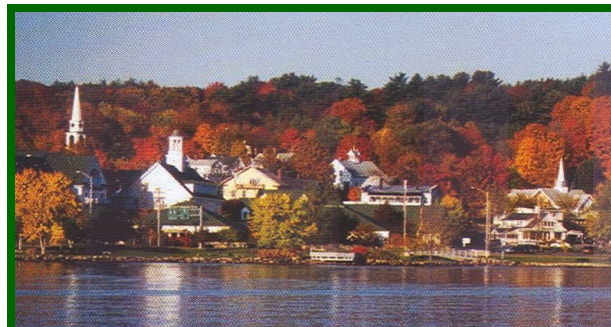
Day 9 We'll travel through the Adirondacks and the Poconos, the valleys and towns, spending the night in Hagerstown, MD. (B)

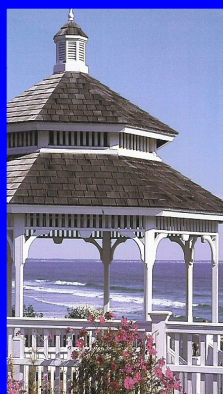

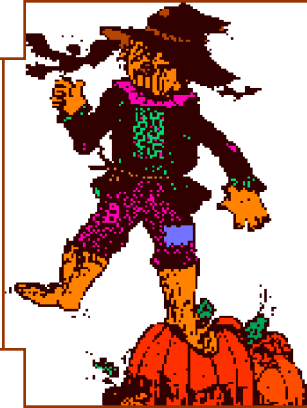
