You will truly enjoy the entertaining and informative narrative of 400 years of island history and folklore as you ride along in the Original Vintage Green Trolley. Our guide will also point out the best places to eat, shop, and play. It's the perfect way to see and experience island life while getting a good overview of the entire island.
